

ACTIVITIES OCCURRING AT FORT MONMOUTH

I hear people say regularly that not a lot is happening at Fort Monmouth, but just the contrary there is a lot going on as these pictures will show you. Things are changing daily. It is hard to keep up with the changes.

Main Post Housing was sold to RPM Developers. They have created two separate projects. The officer housing on the north side of Greely Field, (Russel, Carty, Allen) now known as the East Gate, and the former Senior NCO housing on Goslin is called Liberty Walk. The Oct 21st Asbury Park Press reported that 20 of the 56 homes in East Gate have been sold. The Liberty Walk Goslin units started renting on October 1st. Rents are priced from \$3,000 per month.



The Myer Center (Hex) is being dismantled. It was recently reported that RWJ Barnabas Health will purchase the 36 Acres associated with the Myer Center (HEX) area and is planning to build a medical campus. The health system's project is expected to include a Cancer Institute of New Jersey center that could be as big as 100,000 square feet.



The former CECOM Safety building is being demolished in preparation for the construction of housing on the former office building site in the Charles Wood Area.



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Building 2525 (adjacent to the Myer Center) was sold last year to AASKI and their headquarters and other company are located in the building. They have done a nice job of renovating the building exterior.



Trinity Hall Purchased the Child Development Center. Trinity Hall is an innovative, independent all-girls college preparatory high school educating and empowering young women in the Catholic tradition. They are constructing an addition to the CDC.
